### **Guidelines for Fan the Flame Open Air Mass**

- Young people must be registered to volunteer by returning this signed form by Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> May
- Young people should arrive 8.30am-9am at Celtic Park
- Young people will receive a wristband and will record their emergency contact number on this
- Young People will be briefed on their volunteer roles when they have arrived and signed in. Jobs will include ushers, youth stewards, set-up, flag bearers.
- Tea and Coffee with snacks will be available and lunch will be provided
- Young people must be collected by 1.45pm or make their way home as arranged by the parent/guardian or school

### **Code of Conduct for Young People**

- Young people must sign in on arrival, sign out before departure and have a signed parental consent form to partake
- On registering you will receive a wristband which must be worn for the duration of the event
- Young people are not permitted to leave the grounds of Celtic park
- Young people are required to stay in their designated areas and follow their leader's instructions
